



# CHURCHILL WAR ROOMS

The Churchill War Rooms offers guests an unparalleled opportunity to walk back in recent history. A unique facility comprising of the most important surviving part of the underground emergency accommodation which was provided to protect Sir Winston Churchill, his War Cabinet and the Chiefs of Staff of Britain's Armed Forces against air attacks during the Second World War. The rooms are situated in the basement of the Government offices on Great George Street beneath a slab of protective concrete and were in operational use from August 27, 1939 to the Japanese surrender in 1945.

Opened in February 2005 within the War Rooms, the Churchill Museum is the only major museum in the world dedicated to this important historical figure and features a permanent exhibition depicting the chapters of his life, offering a truly exciting, high tech and interactive addition to this fascinating attraction.
